DESCRIPTION OF WORK OF THIS CONTRACT

You are invited to bid on a general contract. The Contract provides for the construction of a Powdered Activated Carbon (PAC) Feed System and associated site work at the Clinton Lake Water Treatment Plant.

BID INFORMATION

Bids will be received by the City of Clinton, Oklahoma until 2:00 p.m. local time, August 10, 2021. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids will be received at the following location:

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is: **QuestCDN**. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays during **normal business hours**, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

All Prime Bidders must obtain copies of Bidding Documents from Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company through QuestCDN, upon payment of a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit to QuestCDN for an electronic set of documents. Bidding Documents for use in preparing bids may be viewed and downloaded by registering with QuestCDN online at www.QuestCDN.com (QUEST Project #7940132) or by calling 952-233-1632. Bidders may view the Bidding Documents at no cost on QuestCDN; however, to be considered a Plan Holder, Bidder must register on www.QuestCDN.com and download the documents. Only registered Plan Holders will receive addenda and updates.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at **Clinton City Hall** Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **8:00 am and 4:00 pm**.

Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. A hard copy of the Bidding Documents must be submitted with the Bid.

A prebid conference will be held as stated in the Instructions to Bidders on July 28, 2021 at 2 p.m. local time at the Clinton Lake WTP – 10906 N 2110 Rd, Foss, OK 73647.

Bids will be received on a lump sum basis.

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Bidders shall be qualified to do business and licensed in accordance with all applicable laws of the state and local governments where the Project is located. Bids received from Bidders who are not recorded as having received the Bid Documents will not be opened.

Prequalification of Bidders will not be required. Owner will evaluate Bidders in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid security in the form of a certified or bank cashier's check or a Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of total Bid price shall accompany each Bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. Bids shall be in accordance with the Bid Documents.

Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately after time stated above.

COMPLETION

Completion time shall be as follows:

The Work shall be Substantially Completed within 448 days of the Contractor Notice to Proceed, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the GENERAL CONDITIONS within 45 days after Substantial Completion.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

All bids must include assurances that the following provisions will be complied with:

- A. Federal Labor Standards Provisions, US Department of Labor, 29 CFR 5.
- B. Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1974, as amended; 12 U.S.C. 1701U, which requires that, to the greatest extent feasible, opportunities for training and employment be given lower-income residents of the project area and contracts for work in substantial part by persons residing in the area of the project.
- C. Section 109 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, which assures that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, natural origin or sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of or be subjected to discrimination.
- D. Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities, which assures the bidder does not maintain or provide any segregated facilities.
- E. Equal Opportunity Provisions – Executive Order 11246, as amended, which assures non-discrimination.
- F. Minority Business Enterprise and Women Business Enterprise provisions which encourage minority-owned business and women-owned businesses to bid on the project.
- G. Assurances that surety companies executing bonds appear on the Treasury Department's list and are authorized to transact business in the State where the project is located.

OWNER'S RIGHT TO REJECT

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive irregularities therein, and all Bidders shall agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of the Owner for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, nor shall the Bidders seek any recourse of any kind against the Owner because of such rejections. The filing of any Bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.
