

## RESOLUTION NO. 1012

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR USE OF TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDS SET FORTH BY THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT (IIJA) FOR THE "CITY OF CLINTON/CLINTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS PHASE I NEW SIDEWALKS PROJECT" IN CLINTON, OKLAHOMA AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO SIGN THIS APPLICATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, Oklahoma has prepared for submittal an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds in the amount of \$1,038,054.21 set forth by IIJA and as outlined in ODOT's transportation alternatives program guidance & application packet for 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, is participating as an eligible project sponsor in the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's transportation alternatives program set forth by IIJA; and

**WHEREAS**, federal monies are available under a transportation alternatives program set forth by IIJA, administered by the state of Oklahoma, Department of Transportation, for the purpose of creating and promoting the planning and development of active transportation facilities and programs in Oklahoma; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, acknowledges availability of the required local match of no less than 20%; and

**WHEREAS**, after appropriate public input and due consideration, the governing body of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, has recommended that an application be submitted to the state of Oklahoma for the "Clinton/CPS Phase I New Sidewalks Project".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, does hereby authorize the City of Clinton to submit an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds set forth by IIJA on behalf of the citizens of Clinton, Oklahoma.

Section 2. That the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the "Clinton/CPS Phase I New Sidewalks Project" is available in the City's FYE26 Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3. That the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance

of the "Clinton/CPS Phase I New Sidewalks Project" will be available for the life of the project.

Section 4. That the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that the City of Clinton, Oklahoma will have title or permanent easements for the "Clinton/CPS Phase I New Sidewalks Project" by the time of project letting, if necessary.

Section 5. That the chief project sponsor, the City of Clinton, Oklahoma is authorized to sign the application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds set for by the IJA on behalf of the citizens of Clinton, Oklahoma. The chief project sponsor is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma in this and subsequent related activities.
