The Clinton Round-Up Club will be hosting an IPRA Rodeo (International Professional Rodeo Association) this summer. This will be our 3rd consecutive year to bring in a professional rodeo to Clinton. In doing so, we would like to do as much as possible to continue to make this one of the best rodeos we have brought to Clinton. The Clinton Rodeo will be on held on Friday night, July 17th and Saturday night, July 18th.
