

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for **CLINTON WATER TREATMENT PLANT CLARIFIER REHAB PAINTING**, to be conducted for the Clinton Public Works Authority, Clinton, Oklahoma, located at the Clinton Water Treatment Plant, will be received at 415 Gary Boulevard, Clinton, Oklahoma 73601 until 3:00 P.M. on December 2, 2008 at which time the bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud. Sealed bids submitted prior to the bid opening should be set to the Office of the City Clerk at P.O. Box 1177 Clinton, OK 73601.

The project includes, but is not limited to, cleaning and re-coating steel mechanisms within two (2) 60' diameter clarifier tanks and associated support structure, as indicated in the specifications.

Bid documents (specifications, proposal forms, and other contract documents) may be examined at GARVER ENGINEERS, 1016 24<sup>TH</sup> Avenue NW, Norman, Oklahoma 73069. Bid documents may be purchased from GARVER ENGINEERS for **forty (\$40.00)** per set. NO REFUNDS will be made and no partial sets will be issued.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to the Owner, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. Such bid guarantee shall be made payable to the Clinton Public Works Authority.

The successful bidder must furnish a performance, payment, and maintenance bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Oklahoma to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

Proposals and affidavits must be made on bidder's proposal form only, and filled in a sealed envelope. Each envelope shall bear a legible notation thereon that is a bid upon the project advertised. The copy shall be filed with the City Clerk, in the City Clerk's office. All proposals shall be either typewritten or written in ink.

Bids must remain in effect for 60 days after the bid opening date.

The Clinton Public Works Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bids and bidding deemed to be in the best interest of The Clinton Public Works Authority, and to reject nonconforming, nonresponsive, or conditional bids.

A pre-bid conference will be held on Thursday, November 13, 2008 at 10:00 A.M. at Clinton Water Treatment Plant located at I-40 Exit 50 and one mile north. The pre-bid conference is mandatory.
