THIS CONTRACT made and entered into this 06-30-2008, by and between the Oklahoma Arts Council hereinafter referred to as the Council, and City of Clinton P.O. Box 1177 Clinton,OK 736011177 herein referred to as Applicant.

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Council to have the Applicant participate in programming partially funded through the Council's Local Government Challenge Grant Program:

THEREFORE the Council agrees to provide assistance for services provided by the Applicant as follows:

I. TERM. The term of this contract shall commence no earlier than the 1st day of July 2008 and shall be completed no later than the 30th day of June 2009

II. APPLICANT SERVICES. The Applicant agrees that financial assistance received from the Council shall be used for eligible programming expenses as outlined in the Local Government Challenge Grant application:

III. PAYMENT OF OKLAHOMA ARTS COUNCIL Local Government Challenge Grant Grant. The Council agrees that it shall provide assistance in the amount of :5000

or the actual deficit of the project, whichever is smaller. The amount will be processed following the completion of the project and the Council's receipt and approval of the applicant's Final Report which is due within 30 days of the ending date of the project as stated by the applicant in the application. Applicant further acknowledges that failure to file a final report by the due date shall result in termination of financial assistance.

IV. ASSURANCES. Applicant receiving financial assistance must comply with the legal assurances agreed to on the Local Government Challenge Grant application.

V. WITHDRAWAL. In the event the Applicant decides that the Council's approved financial assistance is not required or that the organization's actual revenues fall short of the required match, the Applicant must notify the Council immediately, in writing, of this change.

VI. FUNDING. In the event that the funds available for financial assistance are reduced or cancelled, the parties agree that the amount of money shown in this agreement may be reduced accordingly or the agreement may be cancelled in its entirety upon written notice of the Oklahoma Arts Council.

VII. AUDITS. The Oklahoma Arts Council shall reserve the right to request an audit of the applicant's documentation for the approved programming including financial records.

VIII. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ASSISTANCE. Applicants receiving financial assistance from the Council must include the following credit line on all printed promotional and program materials for the programming receiving financial assistance with these funds:

Failure to include the credit line or the Oklahoma Arts Council logo on all printed promotional and program materials for the assisted programming may result in the termination of the approved Council financial assistance.
