
Dear Mr. Grayson,

AGREEMENT WITH INTEGRIS CLINTON REGIONAL HOSPITAL TO PROVIDE
HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS

NOW COME the parties, INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital and The City of Clinton, Oklahoma, enter into this Agreement on the ____ day of _____, 2009 stating as follows:

WHEREAS, it is the mission of INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital to provide excellent health services for our communities, and

WHEREAS, as part of that mission, the Board of Trustees of INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital have made a commitment to provide free and reduced priced services to residents of our community who do not have the ability to pay for urgent and/or emergency services, and

WHEREAS, The City of Clinton, Oklahoma, includes low income individuals who are not entitled to benefits under title XVIII of the Social Security Act or eligible for assistance under the State under that title,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for The City of Clinton desire to recognize that INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital, as part of its mission, to provide and continue a valued and needed community service of providing health care services to low income individuals, including residents of The City of Clinton.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties AGREE as follows:

1. INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital will provide health care services to low income individuals residing in the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, who are not entitled to benefits under title XVIII of the Social Security Act or eligible for assistance under the State plan under that title in an amount as determined by the INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital Board of Directors.
2. INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital will annually provide a report to The City of Clinton, Oklahoma, describing the type and amount of free and reduced services provided by INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital for the preceding fiscal year of June 30.
3. The City of Clinton, Oklahoma shall have no obligations under this Agreement.
4. Either party may terminate this Agreement with thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
5. In the event that either party decides to terminate this agreement, notice should also be provided to the Office of Pharmacy Affairs, Health Care Systems Bureau, 5600 Fishers Lane, Mail Stop 10C-03, Rockville, Maryland, 29857.

As long as this agreement is in effect, The City Manager or his designee, shall be authorized here under to sign and certify any document(s) required to certify that INTEGRIS Clinton Regional Hospital is under contract with The City of Clinton to provide health care services to low income individuals. Further, the City Council hereby delegates authority to exercise The City's right to terminate this agreement as her or she may deem appropriate, with or without prior City Council approval.
