Item Title/ Subject: Surplus Airport Lights – Donate lights to City of Sayre

History/Background Information:

The City of Sayre contacted the City of Clinton regarding our old runway lighting/globes. The City replaced its lighting on the Clinton Airport this past December. This created a large surplus of lighting (approximately 60 additional globes).

Item/Subject Summary:

Tracy Yoder (City Fixed Base Operator) recommends we keep at least 15 globes for the future needs, as a backup. City of Sayre needs approximately 30-50 globes. Sayre does not have the funding to purchase this lighting.

Recommendation:

I recommend we hold back 20 of our lighting globes for unforeseen issues in the future (backup). Donating the surplus to the City of Sayre would be appropriate.
