**4A. DISCUSS DONATION OF LAND FROM LAWRENCE SMOOTS ON BEHALF OF EDNA CARTER TO THE CITY OF CLINTON**

City Manager Steve Hewitt reported that Mr. Lawrence Smoots had contacted the City about donating two lots that are adjacent to Joe Baker Park to the City of Clinton. He said there is currently a structure on the property and the cost of cleanup is unknown. He said after the structure is cleared off, the property could be used as a parking lot for Joe Baker Park.

Councilman Marcy asked about the cost for tearing down the house.

City Manager Hewitt said he did not have that cost.
