

**MINUTES OF THE CLINTON CITY COUNCIL  
MAY 19, 2015**

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, Custer County, held in the City Council Room, City Hall on Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. A notice of this meeting with agenda was posted on the bulletin board in the lobby of Clinton City Hall on Friday, May 15, 2015.

Conan Wilson opened the meeting with prayer and Councilman Wheeler Lowry led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**AGENDA ITEM NO. 3: CONSENT AGENDA**

**4A. CONSIDER CONTINUANCE OF CONDEMNATION FOR PROPERTY IN THE 200  
BLOCK OF WEST MODELLE OWNER: JUAN BARRIENTOS**

Building Inspector Toby Anders reported that the property owners have begun demolition and have moved the property. He said that trailer is 75% gone.

Mr. Barrientos said the project would be complete by the end of the week pending weather.

Mr. Barrientos daughter said they had not applied for a demolition period because they were not aware that one was needed but that the cleanup should be completed by the end of the week if the weather allows.

Motion was made by Councilman Rodolph and seconded by Councilman Hulin to waive the demolition period and allow 30 days for the completion of the cleanup.

**4C. CONSIDER ORDINANCE NO. 757A REGARDING CLINTON CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS**

City Clerk Lisa Anders explained that Ordinance 757 established the rules and regulations for the Clinton Cemetery. Ordinance 757A gives a specific definition for the material used for permanent and temporary markers or monuments at the Clinton Cemetery.

Motion was made by Councilman Hulin and seconded by Councilman Lowry to adopt Ordinance 757A regarding the Clinton Cemetery Rules and Regulations.
