Minutes of a Public Hearing held in the Clinton City Council Room, City Hall on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 5:30 P.M. A notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the lobby of the Clinton City Hall on January 25, 2016.

The public hearing was held to review and discuss the amount of federal dollars expended and, the percentage of low-moderate income persons impacted and the project's results and accomplishments. The maximum grant amount of \$150,000.00. The application for a rescue fire truck quoted at \$154,176.00 will be requested. The higher the rate of match by the City, the more points received in the grant evaluation.

City Manager Mark Skiles said if awarded, the City would have two years to utilize the grant. He said that at the previous meeting during the discussion of purchase of a fire rescue vehicle, interest for financing had been discussed. He said the City would also have two years to accumulate the matching funds.

SWODA representative Clyde Morgan explained that the fire rescue vehicle should be in the top five on the Capital Improvement Plan.
