AGENDA ITEM NO. 6: CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

City Manager Mark Skiles asked Lonnie Teel to provide an update on the various projects.

Lonnie Teel said the surveyor is working on the lots for the Clinton Commerce Center and laying out the roads. He said mowing will be done to prepare a path before the grader and bulldozer are brought in. The sewer lines will be installed and then the water lines. The next step would be the excavators and then the pavers.

He reported that the boring is underway on the golf course line and they will be finishing the boxes. He said 580 feet of line would be laid. He said they are waiting on air vaults. He said once the wells are on line, the lines will be pumped.

Councilman Rodolph asked about the slip line.

Mr. Teel said that slip line had not been started. He said the Igo had received the contract and work would begin when he is ready.

City Manager Mark Skiles reported that the construction of the new Dollar General Store is underway and should make the transition from the old facility to the new after the first of the year.

Mavis Wilks asked about the progress on the clean-up of the apartments on South 23rd. She said she had spoken with the property owner about the project but did not see any progress in the past four to six weeks.
