Minutes of a Public Hearing held in the Clinton City Council Room, City Hall on Wednesday, June 14, 2017 at 5:00 P.M. A notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the lobby of the Clinton City Hall on June 7, 2017 and an ad was placed in the *Clinton Daily News* on Friday, June 9, 2017.

The public hearing was to discuss the proposed City of Clinton Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Annual Budget.

City Manager Mark Skiles explained that the only revisions made to the proposed budget was to include the request from Multi-County Youth Service for \$20,000 and the additional funding for Animal Control. He said the budget as presented is at a \$171,000 deficit. He said this includes the 7% reduction in estimated sales tax collections.

City Manager Skiles said the budget will be presented for consideration at the June 20, 2017 City Council meeting.

Mayor/Chairman David Berrong explained that the Public Hearing gives the public an opportunity to ask questions and make comments.

There were no questions, comments or statements from the audience.

The public hearing was adjourned.
