Minutes of a Public Hearing held in the Clinton City Council Room, City Hall on Tuesday, September 19, 2017 at 5:30 P.M. A notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board in the lobby of the Clinton City Hall, Frisco Center and the Clinton Public Library on September 8, 2017..

The public hearing was to discuss the current Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for the purchase of a Fire Rescue Truck.

SWODA Representative Clyde Morgan explained that CDBG had provided \$88,088.00 toward the purchase of the fire rescue truck. Part of the requirements for the grant is to implement a citizen's participation plan and the plan includes two public hearings.

The CDBG funding is through HUD and the city had a matching fund of \$49,452.00 for the project.

Councilman Stewart asked if the truck will work.

Clinton Fire Department Chief Forrest Valentine said the truck will definitely work. He said the equipment has been transferred to it and a study is being conducted to determine where to mount the tool. He said it is function now. He explained that it is customary to have a primary and secondary tool.

There were no questions, comments or statements from the audience.

The public hearing was adjourned.
