City Manager Mark Skiles reported that there had been a water leak at the Southwest Playhouse.

City Manager Mark Skiles introduced Brent Almquest of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. Mr. Almquest reported on the various ODOT projects in the area. He said that

Phase I of the Exist 65 Project was the public hearing held at the Frisco Center and that Phase II will be starting with the agreement with Garver Engineering who will review the first consultants ideas and will prepare a final design. He said a public hearing will follow the final design to review the proposal.

Almquest explained the inspections of the bridges in the area. He said the bridge east of Clinton is scheduled to be replaced in 2021.

Councilman Stewart asked about Gary Boulevard repairs and the possibility of opening up the west end of Frisco to Gary Boulevard.

Mr. Almquest said it is ODOT responsibility and they work with the City of Clinton. He suggested a meeting between the City and ODOT to discuss the possibility of opening up Frisco to Gary Boulevard.
