With the recent success of our high school soccer teams, Girls 2018 State Champions and Boys 2015 State Runner-Up, we feel like now is the time to showcase not only our high school teams but also our city's commitment to soccer and the community support we receive. Our tournament will host 16 teams, 8 boys and 8 girls, from across the state of Oklahoma. Teams will be coming from as far away as Miami, Tulsa, and Newkirk. This tournament will bring an economic boost to our community. We are expecting 4-5 of these teams to stay in our local hotels. As well as all of the teams, including parents and fans to eat and shop in our community. We are finding there are many cost associated with hosting a tournament; including officials fees, rental cost for restroom facilities, and other unforeseen items.
