4A. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON PROPOSALS FOR REPLACEMENT OF TOWER AND REFURBISHING WATER SLIDE AT CLINTON MUNICIPAL POOL

Morgan Bonnarens, Recreation Director, reported that bids had been taken on the replacement of the tower and refurbishing the water slide. One bid was received from Artic Air and Refrigeration in the amount of \$76,407.00 for the refurbishing of the water slide and three bids were received for the replacement of the tower:

Tony Littleton of Artic Air reviewed his proposal regarding the slide tower. He said he would be using local contractor, CPI to do the power coating of the steel structure.

Mayor Berrong asked the timeline for the project.

Mr. Littleton said it would like 2-3 weeks to acquire the metal. He said the project would be completed by opening day of Memorial Day. He also explained that Monte Goucher would inspect and provide an engineer's certificate.

Councilman Rodolph said the tower would have to be completed first before the work on the slide could begin.

Mr. Littleton said that Artic Air would take down the old structure and install the new. He said a crane would be brought in and that Driver's Welding would be doing all the welding on the project.

Motion was made by Councilman Rodolph and seconded by Councilman Stewart to award the bid for refurbishing the Slide tower to Artic Air & Refrigeration in the amount of \$76,407.00.

Morgan Bonnarens said that SlidePros offered a longer warranty and their price is reasonable.
