4B. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON RENEWAL OF LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SINOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE FOR 523 GARY BLVD.

Johnny Redd of Sinor Emergency Medical Service explained that Sinor has been awarded a grant and the funding of the grant will be used for the remodeling of their current facility on Gary Boulevard near Sonic. He said the garage in the back would be remodeled to allow for bedrooms for the house crew. He said they have been utilizing the fire station building at 523 Gary Blvd but with the grant they can utilize property they already own. The lease contract expires January 2019 and the move is planned for March 2019. He said a three month termination clause is included in the contract. He said he hated to enter into a three year contact and yet ask for termination after three months.
