Our Lady Reds were the 2017 State Class 4A Champions which was a 1st for Clinton High School Soccer. In 2015, Our Reds were the 2015 State Runner Up. In 2018, our Lady Reds made the Semifinals for the 4th year, which has never been done here in Clinton.
