

**MINUTES OF THE CLINTON CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 19, 2019**

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Mayor and Councilmen of the Clinton City Council, City of Clinton, Oklahoma, Custer County, held in the City Council Room, City Hall on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. A notice of this meeting with agenda was posted on the bulletin board in the lobby of Clinton City Hall on Thursday, February 14, 2019.

A. Minutes of Regular Meeting of February 5, 2019

Motion was made by Councilman Hulin and second by Councilman Rosales that Consent Agenda Item No. 3 (a) be approved.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 4: ACTION ITEMS

4A. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON REQUEST FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE TWO PICKUPS

Police Chief Paul Rinkel explained that the current budget contains funding for the purchase of three Detective vehicles. He said that historically the vehicles have been cars but staff is requesting the purchase of two crew cab pickups which are priced under the state bid price.

City Manager Mark Skiles said the choices for vehicles are Challenger, SUV, or pickups and there are no Dodge dealers in Clinton.

Chief Rinkel explained that the request is for two units and radio equipment which would be covered with the funds designated in the budget.

Motion was made by Councilman Dowdell and seconded by Councilman Rosales to authorize the purchase of two pickups for the Police Department.

4B. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY TO THE CLINTON INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY

City Attorney Ryan Meacham explained that the City of Clinton had purchased property from Denny Meacham to allow for the issuance of a tax credit. The property is now being transferred to the Clinton Industrial Authority.

Motion was made by Councilman Stewart and seconded by Councilman Dowdell to transfer the property to the Clinton Industrial Authority.

4C. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON CONDEMENTION AT 605 SOUTH 13TH – OWNER: WILLIAM F CRYER AND/OR NINNIE E. CRYER

Building Inspector Toby Anders presented information and photos of the property at 605 South 13th. He said this property had been presented to the Council for consideration prior and there had been little improvements to the property. He said he had not been on the inside for an interior inspection but recommended proceeding with the condemnation process and give the 30 days' notice as required.

Councilman Stewart said the only work to be performed in the three months time was the removal of the porch and not all of the time consisted of bad weather.

Motion was made by Councilman Stewart and seconded by Councilman Dowdell to proceed with condemnation at 605 South 13th.
