RESOLUTION 890

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA,
ESTABLISHING THE NAME OF THE PARK LOCATED IN THE
AVANTS 1ST AND RED PLUME ADDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton owns the real property located at Lots 1 through 6, inclusive, Block 4, Red Plume Addition and Lots 1 through 3, inclusive, Block 1, Avant's 1st Addition ("the Property");

WHEREAS, the Property has been constructed and utilized as a public park;

WHEREAS, the Red Knights are an international motorcycle club, which has a local chapter;


