

## **SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE**

Under and by virtue of Section 5(a), Article XVIII, of the Oklahoma Constitution, Title 11 Oklahoma Statutes, Section 16-101, and City of Clinton Resolution 898 dated this 20 day of August, 2019, authorizing the calling of an election on the proposition hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned Mayor/President of the Board of Trustees of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, call a special election and give notice to be held in the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, on the 12 day of November 2019, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters in the City, the following proposition:

### PROPOSITION

An ordinance granting to Public Service Company of Oklahoma (PSO) the right, privilege, and non-exclusive franchise for 25 years to build, equip, maintain, extend, own, and operate a system for the manufacture, transmission, distribution, sale, and control of electricity and communications circuits for itself and others in, under, over, across, through, and along any and all of the present and future streets, alleys, avenues, ways, and other public places and grounds within the limits of the City of Clinton, Custer County, Oklahoma; and granting PSO the right to operate an electric business pursuant to reasonable rules and regulations by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission; with PSO agreeing to charge legal rates for the electric service; and, if possible, to sell and deliver to the City all electricity and services requested by it; providing for payment to the City by PSO of a monthly fee on gross receipts from the delivery and sale of electricity; and providing for the repeal of conflicting ordinances; and declaring an emergency.

Shall the proposed ordinance be approved?

FOR THE PROPOSITION - YES

AGAINST THE PROPOSITION - NO

That only registered, qualified voters of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, may vote upon the proposition.

The polls must be opened at seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and kept open continuously until seven o'clock (7:00) P.M.

Those precinct officers designated by the Custer County Election Board, which officers will also act as counters and certify the results as required by law, will conduct the election.

The number and location of the polling places for the election will be the same as prescribed by the County Election Board for state and county elections and will include all precincts totally or partially contained within the limits of the City of Clinton.
