AGENDA ITEM NO.2. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON RESOLUTION 906 REGARDING ESTABLISHING FILING PERIOD AND MUNICIPAL ELECTION DATES AS A RESULT OF MISCOMMUNICATION WITH COUNTY ELECTION BOARD AND STATE ELECTION BOARD FILING REQUIREMENTS AND PENDING DEADLINES

Custer County Election Board Secretary Ann Brown explained that the City of Clinton is a home charter city. She said that several years ago the City chose to amend their charter so as to call the municipal election to coincide with state elections. She said the changes in time affected the regulations for overseas and military ballots. She also explained that the dates of elections depends on whether it is an odd or an even year.

Ms. Brown said that once the resolution was submitted to the State Election Board it was found that the date for the filing period was in error. She noted that the deadline for the resolution is today, June 10, 2020 and that is the reason for an emergency meeting.

Motion was made by Councilman McComas and seconded by Councilman Stewart to approve Resolution 906 establishing the filing period as June 15-16-17, 2020,
