**Item Title/ Subject:** Request Budget amendment for the purchase of new handguns for Police Department to be paid for by the sale and surplus of the old duty weapons and trade in of confiscated weapons and excess ammunition.

**History/Background Information:** For about 20 years the Clinton Police Department has issued both the Gen 3 Glock 22 .40 caliber and the Gen 3 Glock 21 45 ACP. The average life expectancy of a police duty weapon is about 10 years and many of these weapons have been issued to several different Officers at various times and are twenty years old.

**Subject Summary:** Purchase twenty (20) Gen 5 Glock 17 9mm handguns, holsters, and magazine pouches using funds from trade in of confiscated weapons, current duty weapons and excess ammunition. This project would be self-sufficient and there would be NO loss from any city funds. All monies required will be generated as stated.

**Price/Cost:** \$13,500 Capital Improvement funds, offset completely by sale/trade in of old duty weapons, confiscated weapons and surplus ammo.
