

ORDINANCE NO. 1006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLINTON EXTENDING THE SUNSET PROVISION IN CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 5 MANDATING THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS WITH SOME EXCEPTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, The City Council adopted Ordinance 1002, mandating face coverings in certain situations;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance contained a Sunset provision ;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the ordinance mandating the wearing of face coverings in certain situations is should continue for an additional period of time.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA,

The Sunset provision of TITLE 5, CHAPTER 4 COVID-19 PANDEMIC shall be amended to read as follows:

: SUNSET:

This ordinance shall expire the earlier of: **April 30, 2021**; the expiration of all COVID-19 related emergency declarations issued by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma and the President of the United States of America; or repeal, modification or extension by the City Council through a subsequent ordinance.

: SEVERABILITY:

If any provision, section or portion of this ordinance is found or determined by a court for any reason to be invalid or unenforceable, those provisions shall be severed from the remaining portion of this ordinance, which shall remain effective in the absence of any invalid or unenforceable provision.
