

ORDINANCE NO. 1007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CLINTON AMENDING THE SUNSET PROVISION IN CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 5 MANDATING THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS WITH SOME EXCEPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance 1002 on November 17, 2020, mandating face coverings in certain situations and extended the mandate to April 30, 2021 by Ordinance 1006 on January 19, 2021;

WHEREAS, the CDC has begun to relax restrictions related to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, vaccinations in the City have begun and active cases of COVID-19 have been significantly reduced;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the ordinance mandating the wearing of face coverings in certain situations should end earlier than previously provided.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA,

The Sunset provision of TITLE 5, CHAPTER 4 COVID-19 PANDEMIC shall be amended to read as follows:

: SUNSET:

This ordinance shall expire on the _____ day of April, 2021.

: SEVERABILITY:

If any provision, section or portion of this ordinance is found or determined by a court for any reason to be invalid or unenforceable, those provisions shall be severed from the remaining portion of this ordinance, which shall remain effective in the absence of any invalid or unenforceable provision.

EMERGENCY PROVISION

An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication.
