agreement and the “proposed agreement”. Discussion was held and comments were made regarding the changes requested in service type ALS vs BLS, meter subsidy versus flat rate, contract period and rate change, discounts to customers, Emergency Services Board, some contract housekeeping details to include 30 day notice, and market exclusivity.

The Council requested that the City Attorney review the contract and provide further information to the Council at a future meeting.
