

**RESOLUTION IA 21-01**

**DECLARING CERTAIN CITY OF CLINTON VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT TO BE  
SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY AUCTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton Frisco Center has identified equipment, as listed on attachment "A" to this Resolution, which have outlived their useful life and/or are no longer necessary or useful to the Clinton Industrial Authority at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-3 of the Clinton City Charter provides that surplus equipment may be disposed of by competitive bidding under regulations which the Clinton Industrial Authority may prescribe; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the determination of the Clinton Industrial Authority that it is in best interest of the City to dispose of the vehicles set forth in Exhibit "A" through an auction in an effort to obtain the best value for them.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Trustees of the Clinton Industrial Authority hereby authorizes the auction of the Clinton Industrial Authority-owned equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
