

ORDINANCE NO. 10 13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 9, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA, TO PROVIDE A DEFINITION FOR “DESIGNATED AREAS”, PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is appropriate to amend Title 7, Chapter 5, Section 9 of the Clinton City Code to include additional clarity regarding the parking of automobiles in the front yard of residential areas;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma:

Section 1: That Title 7, Chapter 5, §7-5-9 shall be amended to include the following underlined language:

7-5-9: PARKING IN FRONT YARDS:

It is unlawful to park a vehicle on the grass in the front yard of a lot used for residential purposes. This section does not apply to parking in areas designated to satisfy off street parking requirements.

“Areas Designated to Satisfy Off Street Parking” shall mean: an improved area used as a means of ingress and egress, not exceeding twenty four feet in width and being coterminous with the traveled portion of the public or private road right of way, provided that the improved area shall not occupy over forty percent (40%) of the total required front yard which is required by Title 11, Chapter 5 of this Code.

Section2:

All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and replaced.

Section 3:

If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter, or section shall for any reason be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 4:

Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective July 1, 2022, from and after its passing, approval and publication.
