

ORDINANCE NO. 1015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-1-2(C) OF THE CITY OF CLINTON CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING A SECOND PARAGRAPH TO THIS SECTION REGARDING THE PURCHASE OF CONSUMABLES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, certain essential purchases periodically made by the City, *i.e.* chemicals, fuel, for the uninterrupted provision of services to Clinton citizens can best be described as 'consumables' as they are used and must be replaced in short order; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the various 'consumables' is often volatile on as much as a daily basis making it difficult to know if the purchase exceeds the spending limits requiring prior City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, it is best to acknowledge that 'consumables' are necessary purchases by the City and that the purchasing policies should acknowledge the difference from purchasing capital assets and other supplies by the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA.

Section 3-1-2: Purchases of Goods, Services and Capital

"An exception to City Council approval required for purchases over \$25,000 for goods will apply to consumables delivered in bulk load or transport load such as chemicals or fuel, etc., as price variations per tonnage delivered and hauling fees can cause the total cost to exceed \$25,000 without advance City knowledge".

WHEREAS, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Clinton, and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its passage, as provided by law.

PASSED by the City Council of the City of Clinton on the _____ day of March, 2022, with Emergency Clause approved by separate vote.
