

RESOLUTION 940
DECLARING CERTAIN CLINTON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (CEDA)
ASSETS TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING
THE DISPOSAL OF SAME

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton is the beneficiary of the Clinton Economic Development Authority (CEDA) which has recently acquired the former Glancy Motel in order to facilitate redevelopment;

WHEREAS, the former Glancy Motel property is presently in poor condition and will necessarily be updated before it can be reused; bids are being obtained for asbestos abatement, certain structures will be demolished and there is an accumulation of old motel furnishings (mini refrigerators, et cetera) that need to be disposed of at this time;

WHEREAS, Section 4-3 of the Clinton City Charter provides that surplus equipment may be disposed of by competitive bidding under regulations which the City Council may prescribe; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Clinton City Council that it is in best interest of the City to dispose of the motel furnishings generally referred to above by sale to the highest bidder(s) who can be found in an expeditious manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Clinton hereby declares the above referenced old motel furnishings to be surplus property and authorizes the disposal of same
