

**ORDINANCE NO. 1019**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY CLINTON, OKLAHOMA GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE PERMIT TO DOBSON TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A CABLE SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS**, the City's role as manager of public rights-of-way and easements and as a regulator of cable service requires it to maintain a fair and level playing field for all such service providers; and

**WHEREAS**, City and Dobson have determined that it is in the best interest of all parties, including the citizens of City, that Dobson be granted the right to construct and operate a cable system to provide cable services within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Clinton has relied on Dobson's representations and has considered all information presented to it by Dobson, by City staff, and the public, and has determined that Dobson has the technical, legal and financial ability to construct and operate a cable system and to provide cable services; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon such representations, the City Council of Clinton has determined that it would be in the best interests of the City to grant Dobson a non-exclusive permit to construct, install, maintain and operate a cable system in the City, subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein and applicable federal, state, and municipal statutes, regulations and ordinances, is consistent with the public interest.
