



CITY OF CLINTON PARADE PERMIT APPLICATION

A PERSON DESIRING A PARADE PERMIT SHALL FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE CHIEF OF POLICE ON FORMS PROVIDED BY SUCH OFFICER. SUCH APPLICATION SHALL BE FILED NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS NOR MORE THAN TEN (10) DAYS BEFORE THE DATE ON WHICH IT IS PROPOSED TO CONDUCT PARADE.

THE CHIEF OF POLICE, WHERE GOOD CAUSE IS SHOWN THEREFORE, SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO CONSIDER ANY APPLICATION HEREUNDER WHICH IS FILED LESS THAN SEVEN (7) OR MORE THAN TEN (10) DAYS BEFORE THE DATE SUCH PARADE IS PROPOSED TO BE CONDUCTED.

IF THE PARADE IS DESIGNED TO BE HELD BY, AND ON BEHALF OF OR FOR, ANY PERSON OTHER THAN THE APPLICANT, THE APPLICANT FOR SUCH PERMIT SHALL FILE WITH THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND COMMUNICATION IN WRITING FROM THE PERSON PROPOSING TO HOLD THE PARADE, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICANT TO APPLY FOR THE PERMIT ON HIS BEHALF.
- 12.) ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WHICH THE CHIEF OF POLICE SHALL FIND REASONABLY NECESSARY TO A FAIR DETERMINATION AS TO WHETHER A PERMIT SHOULD BE ISSUED. (1991 CODE § 21-244)
