Project Understanding

The scope of this project shall be to oversee the construction of a rehabilitation of Runway 17/35, consisting of a mill and overlay with a widening, of the existing asphalt pavement, at the Clinton Regional Airport.

Detailed Scope of Services

- A. Task 5CON—Construction Administration Services. Parkhill will:
 - a. Prepare Construction Contract
 - b. Conduct Pre-Construction Meeting
 - c. Review and approve Contractor’s Material Submittals
 - d. Review and approve Contractor’s Monthly Pay Applications
 - e. Review Construction Materials Reports from Owner’s Testing Lab
 - f. Prepare Change Orders (if required)
 - g. Prepare FAA Weekly Inspection Reports
 - h. Conduct Final Inspection and Prepare Punchlist

- B. Task 6RPR—Resident Project Representative Services. Parkhill will:
 - a. Provide RPR Services as detailed in Exhibit C of Owner-Engineer Agreement, “Duties, Responsibilities, and Limitations of Authority of Resident Project Representative”. RPR time reflects 90 Working Days to final Project completion and proposed on lump sum basis

- C. Task 9SSC—Construction Materials Testing and Review Services. Parkhill will:
 - a. Provide required construction materials testing, in accordance with the testing frequencies defined in the Project Specifications, through an independent materials testing laboratory and review all testing that is performed by the Contractor

- D. Task 12OG—OAC Grant Administration Services. Parkhill will:
 - a. Prepare OAC Grant Application
 - b. Prepare Monthly OAC Partial Pay Request Form (reimbursement)
 - c. Prepare Construction Management Program per OAC requirements
 - d. Prepare OAC Closeout Documentation

- E. Task 13DB—Update DBE Goal. Parkhill will:
 - a. Prepare and submit to the FAA the required calculation and update to the DBE Goal, specific to the scope of work covered by the FAA FY 22 grant.
