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To organize a platform to further the development of youth softball in the Clinton Community and the surrounding areas, to enhance player development, and encourage interest and enthusiasm for the sport, and to promote sportsmanship and competition in one complex. This grant would enable us to make entry fees more affordable for each team which would allow us to reach more towns that would have to drive further to play here that normally wouldn't be able to participate. Costs of fall league include softball supplies, awards, equipment, umpires, field equipment, and other unforeseen items. Capturing this grant would enable us to bring teams into the Clinton community 3 nights a week for 5 weeks with a 2-day tournament in the Fall, plus a 5-week League in the Spring with 2 additional tournaments. We would have large numbers of out of town guests spending their money here in Clinton eating, getting fuel, shopping, etc. for an estimated total of 19 nights during our fall season and 24 nights during the spring. This grant would also allow us to continue to put money back in to the facilities. C-Town Girls Softball has recently purchased (along with the City of Clinton) awnings for shade on 2 of the fields, new fences which allow us to host more age divisions on more of the fields, and it has allowed us to be able to host a Spring League with Summer Tournaments.
