

RESOLUTION NO. 947 (A)

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR ELECTION FOR PROPOSED AMENDING, REPEALING AND REPLACING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE 800 OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA; TO ALLOW FOR THE USE OF PRINCIPAL LEASE PAYMENT AMOUNTS THEREUNDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOSPITAL OPERATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is appropriate to amend Ordinance 800 of the Clinton City Code to allow for the use of principal lease payments on deposit, for the purpose of Hospital operations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That an election shall be called on March 7, 2023, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Clinton a proposition for their acceptance or rejection of an amendment to Ordinance 800 of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, as follows:

PROPOSITION

SHALL A PROPOSITION OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA, ENTITLED:

A PROPOSITION AMENDING, REPEALING AND REPLACING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE 800 OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA; TO ALLOW FOR THE USE OF PRINCIPAL LEASE PAYMENT AMOUNTS FROM THE LEASE OF CLINTON REGIONAL HOSPITAL TO BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF HOSPITAL OPERATIONS

BE APPROVED?

SECTION 2: That the call for such special election shall be by proclamation, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk, setting forth the proposition to be voted upon, and the hours of opening and closing of the polls. The ballots for the qualified electors shall be set forth in the proposition substantially as set out in Section 1 hereof, and the returns of such election shall be made to and canvassed by the Custer County Election Board.
