

**RESOLUTION PW 23-02**

**DECLARING CERTAIN CLINTON PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORITY VEHICLES  
AND/OR EQUIPMENT SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY A  
COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS**

**WHEREAS**, the Clinton Public Works Authority (CPWA) has identified vehicles and equipment as listed on Attachment "A" to this Resolution, which have outlived their useful life and/or are no longer necessary or useful to the City at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-3 of the *Clinton City Charter* provides that surplus equipment may be disposed of by competitive bidding under regulations which the City Council may prescribe; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the determination of the Trustees of the Clinton Public Works Authority that it is in best interest of the Authority to declare the vehicles and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" surplus and be disposed of by a competitive bidding process in an effort to obtain the best value for them.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Trustees of the Clinton Public Works Authority hereby declares the CPWA-owned vehicles and/or equipment as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto surplus and authorizes the disposal of them by a competitive bidding process.
