

RESOLUTION 970

**DECLARING CERTAIN CITY OF CLINTON VEHICLES AND/OR EQUIPMENT
TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton has identified vehicles and equipment as listed on Attachment "A" to this Resolution, which have outlived their useful life and/or are no longer necessary or useful to the City at this time; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-3 of the *Clinton City Charter* provides that surplus equipment may be disposed of under regulations which the City Council may prescribe; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Clinton City Council that it is in best interest of the City to declare the vehicles and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" as surplus and dispose of them by a competitive process in an effort to obtain the best value for them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Clinton hereby declares the vehicles and/or equipment set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto as surplus and authorizes the disposal of them by a competitive bidding process.
