Item Title/ Subject: 10th Street Water Line Replacement Frisco - Hayes

History/Background Information: A construction issue has been identified in the water main on 10th Street between Frisco Avenue and Hayes Avenue. Residents on that line have reported water quality results that have not been consistent with water quality in surrounding connected areas.

Rather than spend additional resources to band aid the problem, it has been considered to be replaced as it is a very old cast iron pipe that has been identified for replacement.

The current budget contains \$300,000.00 for water line replacements.

Recommendation: Approve the low and best bid by Lonehickory West LLC to begin asap.

Price/Cost: \$93,550.00.

10TH STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT

I. INTRODUCTION

The water main on 10th Street is an old 4" Cast Iron Pipe (CIP) and has been identified to be replaced. It also is showing signs of a blockage that is requiring an immediate action to be taken. Rather than disrupt services and spend countless resources to investigate further, the PWA is seeking a contractor to replace a 2 block section as soon as possible.

II. WORK TO BE ACCOMPLISHED

The project consists of installing a 6" water main to replace the 4" main on 10th Street between Frisco Avenue and Hayes Avenue, approximately 810 feet, including all fittings and appurtenances. The project will hot tap the 8" CIP main on Frisco and reconnect to the existing 4" at the Hayes intersection with a new 6" valve (for future extension). At Avant Avenue, install on the new main 2 6" CIP Tees with 6" valves and connect to existing 4" CIP mains running along Avant. Two (2) existing fire hydrants are to be connected to the new main as needed. Replaced 4" mains to be capped and abandoned or removed where feasible.

Also in the project are twelve (12) 3/4" services and one (1) 1" service. Contractor will install approved service line to existing meter can, to be connected to meter by PWA personnel.
