

RESOLUTION 983

**DECLARING CERTAIN CLINTON POLICE DEPARTMENT SHOTGUNS
TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY
TRADING THEM IN FOR THREE GLOCK 45 CALIBER PISTOLS**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton has identified eleven shotguns which have outlived their useful life and/or are no longer necessary for use by the Clinton Police Department at this time; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-3 of the *Clinton City Charter* provides that surplus equipment may be disposed of under regulations which the City Council may prescribe; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Clinton City Council that it is in best interest of the City to declare the eleven shotguns as surplus and dispose of them by trading them for three Glock 45 caliber pistols to be issued and utilized by Clinton Police Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Clinton hereby declares the firearms set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto surplus and authorizes the trading of them to COPS Gun Shop/Nonsuch for three Glock 45 caliber pistols.

Harrelson inspected the shotguns and found them in poor condition. Capt. Harrelson took the shotguns to COPS Gun Shop in Oklahoma City and had them evaluated. The 11 shotguns were evaluated for a total of \$1650.00. The owner of COPS Gun Shop agreed to trade three Glock 45's also valued at \$1650.00 for the shotguns.
