Clinton Baseball, Inc and C-Town Softball

This is a list of examples of what Clinton Baseball, Inc and C-Town Softball have done at Schumacher fields with the Tourism grant and tournament money raised in the last 10 years.

Most, if not all, of these projects are in partnership with the City of Clinton or Clinton Public Schools.

Completed projects

- Purchase yearly infield dirt and clay for field and mound repairs.
- Purchased fertilizer for the fields.
- Added awnings for shade on softball fields 2 and 3.
- Added shade on all 3 baseball fields.
- Laid sod around the infield dirt on the softball fields.
- Purchased temporary and chain link fences to fit the needs of little league softball.
- Purchase sports equipment for CHS and CMS teams.
- Paid tournament entry and league fees for C-Town softball teams.
- Donated money for CHS baseball and softball field improvements.
- Put outdoor sound systems on baseball fields.
- Paid to have two new fields on the south side of the complex built that are used for practices and are also now the home for the Noon Lions t ball and machine pitch league.
- Purchased portable sound systems for the softball fields.

Future projects

- Extend the sprinkler system on the softball fields
- Replace scoreboards.

Clinton Baseball, Inc has hosted weekly league games throughout the spring and summer and 4 to 5 weekend tournaments a year for the last 10 years. Beginning in 2017 they started hosting the OKKids 8U Coach Pitch State Tournament. It continues to bring in 16-18 teams from all over the state. They have been awarded that bid once again this Summer. The tournament is tentatively scheduled for June 25-29.

C-Town softball has consistently hosted a summer and fall league that consists of 20-30 teams for the past 10 years. They've also hosted 3-5 weekend tournaments a year during this time. Last year it received the bid to host their first OKKids State Softball Tournament and successfully hosted 18 teams. This year they've received the bid to host the 12U softball OKKids State Tournament and expect 16-24 teams from across the state to attend. The tournament is tentatively scheduled for June 19-23.
