

**SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CLINTON GOLF ADVISORY BOARD
THURSDAY AUGUST 1, 2024, 12:00 p.m.**

The Golf Advisory Board met at the Clinton City Hall in Clinton, Oklahoma on Thursday, August 1, 2024, at 12:00 P.M., with the following members present: Nathan Meget, Brett Johnson, Aaron Hunter, and Luke Adams. Members absent: James Heerwald Others present: Robert Johnston, Amy Jones, and Bobby Richardson.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Luke Adams called the meeting to order at 12:02 P.M.

The minutes from July 3, 2024, special meeting presented for review and approval. The Motion was made by Aaron Hunter and second by Brett Johnson to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

Reports from Course Superintendent

Landon Littke, Course Superintendent reported on the condition of the golf course. He is continuing to monitor the condition of the greens. The extreme heat and the sensitivity of the bentgrass greens has made recovery difficult. Bentgrass is a cool season grass which does best in cool, humid conditions which is not what we have been experiencing; he is continuing to work toward a solution. He has also had two computer stations down which impacted the watering schedule, so he and his staff are presently hand watering those areas.

Discussion ensued regarding the potential closing of at least a portion of the course for a week, Monday through Friday, to see if there was a positive impact on greens recovery. The Golf Advisory Board members were supportive of that idea.

Reports from Golf Professional

Golf Professional Jimmy Laughlin presented information regarding the July statistics with rounds played and golf carts rented. Information was reviewed by the advisory board and discussion was held. Mr. Laughlin suggested that the course be closed to help with the greens recovery and see if less play would help growth.

City Manager Johnston stated that we have had only one member who has inquired about suspending their membership at this time in response to the greens issue. Mr. Johnston also presented information regarding the repair proposal to the suspended bridge. The

Board members discussed options for the bridge repair and stated that additional quotes are needed before a decision is made.
