

7-4-2: AUTHORITY TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN DEVICES:

The city manager, subject to any directions which the city council may give by motion or resolution, shall have placed and maintained traffic control signs, signals, and devices when and as required under the traffic ordinances of the city to make effective the provisions of such ordinances, and may have placed and maintained such additional traffic control signs, signals, and devices as he may deem necessary to regulate traffic under the traffic ordinances of the city or under state law or to guide or warn traffic. (1991 Code § 21-52)

7-4-5: TRAFFIC SIGNS REQUIRED FOR ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES:

No provision of this title for which signs are required shall be enforced against an alleged violator if at the time and place of the alleged violation an official sign is not in proper position and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person. Whenever a particular section does not state that signs are required, such section shall be effective even though no signs are erected or in place. (1991 Code § 21-55)

7-4-8: ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS:

Whenever the city council, by motion or resolution, designates any street or alley or part thereof as a one-way street or alley, the city manager shall have placed and maintained signs giving notice thereof and no such regulation shall be effective unless such signs are in place. Signs indicating the direction of lawful traffic movement shall be placed at every intersection where movement of traffic in the opposite direction is prohibited. (1991 Code § 21-58)
